
Camp Fairview is always an exciting week for us! There's something special about getting

pond and game fields. Exciting times are ahead for Camp Fairview!





















be saved' . . . and with a spark in his eye, pumped his fist and said . . . YES!" Praise God for these 3 young people who called upon the name of the Lord this week!
